Firefighters respond to two early morning house fires

The Redings Mill Fire Protection District responded at 3:06 am to a residential structure fire located at 8857 Stateline Rd. Upon arrival firefighters found a single story residential dwelling fully involved in flames. The owner of the structure, Louis Webster, was not at home at the time of the fire. Eleven Redings Mill firefighters and four apparatus were able to control the fire in approximately one hour and the home was a total loss. The cause of the fire could not be determined due to the extent of damage to the structure. There were no injuries and firefighters were on scene for three hours.

The Redings Mill Fire Protection District then responded at 6:41 am to a residential structure fire located at 7559 Elm Dr. On arrival light smoke was coming from the structure. The fire was found to be in a central heating and air unit. Eleven Redings Mill Firefighters and four apparatus contained the fire to the heating and air unit. The cause of the fire was listed as accidental due to a malfunctioning blower motor. There were no injuries and firefighters were on scene for approximately one hour.
